LIABILITY WAIVER

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You are solely responsible for supervising your dog(s) and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity in which to participate. You must understand that you are participating in this activity at your own risk (and risk of your dog(s)). You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog(s) are physically (or temperamentally) fit and/or adequately skilled to use Paws Place Off-leash Dog Park. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog(s) is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before using the dog park.

WARNING OF RISK

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog(s) and its owner. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death to either the dog(s) or its owner. Dogs are pack animals and when “off leash”, even the best trained dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to another patron or dog(s). Other risks include, but are not limited to the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner; the inability to predict a dog’s reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog(s) due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slipping, falling, premises defects, failure in instruction and or supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog and outdoor activities.

Should you attempt to break up a fight between dogs, you may be attacked and severely mauled by the other dog(s) or even attacked by the other patron. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Buhl Park Corporation to guarantee absolute safety.

WAIVER & RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this facility, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and WAIVING and RELEASING all claims for Injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog(s) might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with presence upon and use of Paws Place off-leash dog park. I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to the dog(s) and its owner in association with participating in dog activities, and I voluntarily agree to abide by all applicable rules and assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that I might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of the dog park. I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge the F. H. Buhl Trustees and Buhl Park Corporation and including its Board of Directors, Staff/Employees, Agents, Volunteers and Sponsors from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that I may have or which may accrue to me and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the use of this facility or surrounding area. I further agree to INDEMNIFY and hold harmless and defend the F. H. Buhl Trustees and Buhl Park Corporation from and against any and all losses, injuries, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions, and expenses (including attorney fees), on account of personal injuries or death to any person or dog(s), or damages to property occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my and my dog’s use of this facility or surrounding area. I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk and waiver and release of all claims.

INFORMATION PACKET

Welcome to Paws Place at Buhl Park!

Thank you for considering a membership at our off-leash dog park.

- ❖ Buhl Park Corporation caretakers monitor Paws Place and can address questions or concerns you may have.
- ❖ This off-leash dog park is a great place to exercise and socialize your dog(s). We want your experience in the park to be pleasant, enjoyable and safe. **NOTE: There is no water source in the dog park, so please be sure to bring with you.**
- ❖ Following is the information to help us accomplish this:
 - ❖ All dogs must be leashed outside Paws Place dog park.
 - ❖ Remember to wear your current Membership lanyard/pass while in the facility. Only one membership holder and their dog(s) should be in the **transfer area** at one time. Please secure gates behind you. *A \$15 fee will be charged to replace a lost/damaged access card and lanyard.*
 - ❖ Owners are responsible for keeping their dog's vaccine status current and for submitting the corresponding records to the Park Office. The following vaccinations are required for membership to Paws Place (please check with your vet to verify your dog's status): rabies, distemper, hepatitis, para influenza, parvovirus, bordetella, leptospirosis, fecal for parasites.
 - ❖ Do not give your card to anyone, other than those listed on your registration, no matter their reason. Direct anyone who asks you to use your access card to contact the Park Office. The cooperation of all members is imperative to maintaining the integrity of this exclusive-use facility.
- ❖ In case of emergency (dog bite or dangerous behavior) immediately call 911 for assistance. All other issues please call:

LOCATION

Paws Place at Buhl Park is located in the southeast area of the park. It is situated between the Avalon Golf and Country Club, Baseball Field, and Tennis Courts.

- ❖ 1.85-acre fenced in Off-leash Dog Park that includes separate areas for small and large dogs
- ❖ Small shade trees, benches, dog waste bags, and garbage/recycling cans
- ❖ Double gated entry with access card entry for security
- ❖ Parking is available adjacent to Paws Place in the parking lot that is shared with the Avalon Golf and Country Club
- ❖ **Water is not available; please bring with you.**

PAW'S Place User Fees

The annual fee provides you with access to the Dog Park for one year from your registration/renewal date.

- ❖ Passes are required for entrance to Paws Place.
- ❖ Passes are not transferrable.
- ❖ Discounts or reduced pricing is not available for partial year use of Paws Place.
 - ❖ **(1 dog) \$30.00**
 - ❖ **(each additional dog) \$5.00**
- ❖ Members will have access to the gated dog park with an access proximity card.
 - ❖ Please do not share this card with non-members.
- ❖ Please wear your Membership Pass in full view to show you are a member and your dog(s) must be wearing a collar displaying current county dog license and rabies tag.
 - ❖ ***Everyone must have a Membership Pass to use Paws Place.***

RULES & REGULATIONS/GUIDELINES FOR USE

1. Users of Paws Place do so at their own risk. Buhl Park Corporation is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog in or outside of the off leash area.
2. Users must comply with the General Rules & Regulations of Buhl Park Corporation.
3. Paws Place is open during regular park hours – 8:00 a.m. to 9:00p.m
4. The following activities or items are prohibited within the confines of Paws Place: food of any kind, dog treats, smoking, littering, bikes, and climbing on or over the fence.
5. Cooperation between dog owners is expected, including keeping order and enforcing Paws Place rules and the Rules & Regulations of Buhl Park.
6. Collars are to be securely fastened and worn at all times. No pincher or spiked collars allowed.
7. Dogs must display a current and valid dog license and rabies tag on their collar.
8. A dog handler 18 or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the action of their dog(s) and any guests accompanying them.
9. No aggressive dogs allowed. Immediately leash your dog and exit Paws Place if aggressive behavior is displayed.
10. Patrons should not chase dogs in Paws Place.
11. Before approaching or handling another dog, obtain permission from the owner.
12. Dogs that are in heat, under 6 months of age, or bark excessively are not permitted in Paws Place.
13. No electronic devices, firearms, explosive devices, noisemakers, and live or dead animals may be utilized for training purposes or any other purpose within Paws Place.
14. Patrons are responsible to clean-up and dispose of feces left by their dog. Failure to pick-up after your dog may result in loss of Paws Place privileges.
15. Patrons are responsible to fill any holes their dog may dig.
16. Failure to comply with the rules may result in loss of privileges and removal from Paws Place.
17. Buhl Park Corporation staff has the authority to close the site for maintenance, weather hazards, rule violations, and special events without prior notice.
18. In case of emergency (dog bite or dangerous behavior) immediately call 911 for assistance and report to Buhl Park Rangers at 724-854-1137.

For all other issues, please call the Park Office at 724-981-5522.

19. Maximum number of dogs per adult is two and both dogs must remain in the same exercise area as their owner. Large dogs (26 pounds and up) are not allowed in the small dog area.
20. Dogs must remain in sight of the owner and should never be left in Paws Place unattended.
21. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and leaving Paws Place. Owners must carry a leash for each dog at all times.
22. Dogs running free in Paws Place should remain away from the gates when other dogs are entering and exiting.
